The goal of this game is to fill your Bingo board with words made from the consonant crushes and the word-endings drawn from the common pile. Print this page on card stock and cut out the bingo boards and the squares to make the word-ending cards. Place the cards face down in a pile and have each player choose one of the Bingo game boards.


Each player in turn draws a word-ending and tries to add it to a consonant crush (or blend) to make a word. If the ending doesn't work on that player's board, it has to be passed on to the other player. The first player to fill his board wins.

For more practice the game can be played using the following point system:& 3 points for completing a line up-and-down, sideways, or diagonally& 2 points for getting an extra ending choice for one consonant crush& 4 points for writing a word with an extra ending such as er, ing, or s& 10 points for being the first player to get at least one ending for every consonant crush
